Child and Adolescent Mental Health Division (CAMHD Report)	<ul> <li>Dr. Stan Michels gave an update on CAMHD activities:</li> <li>The Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration awarded the Alcohol and Drug Abuse Division \$760,000 per year to work with CAMHD on drug treatment programming for adolescents. Ideas for this money include training for youth, or discharge transitions from residential programming.</li> <li>The contract for one of CAMHD's Community Base Residential (CBR) III programs ended June 30, 2017. A new Request for Proposal (RFP) for the CBR program will be issued shortly.</li> <li>Dr. Ulrich, CAMHD's Medical Director has resigned. Dr. Kurt Humphrey will be acting Medical Director while CAMHD seeks another Medical Director.</li> <li>CAMHD has a new initiative to reform quality improvement practice and policies. The initiative is a six (6) months' project to revise the monitoring process for both provider programs and CAMHD services.</li> <li>The Western Interstate Commission for Higher Education (WICHE) will research best practices and review policies.</li> <li>CAMHD's goals for this initiative:</li> <li>Create a dashboard for all levels of care.</li> <li>Request the providers input on their quality of care.
