ewa side) Public parking in Metered stalls 2 hour limit \$1.00 per hour (Quarters)

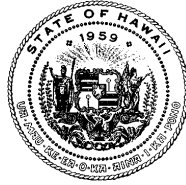
Parking Lot L (Department of Health Public Parking - corner of Beretania & Punchbowl, Pay
